them! Whilst this is impressive, a barn owl's is	even better
than their eyesight. They can hear a mouse's heartbeat up to	9m away! Their
ears are hidden in the disc feathers on their face. They are slig	htly different
sizes and are, with one ear by the eye and	the other one by
the beak. It may seem odd, but this enables the owls to hear	from above and
below and helps them figure out where their is.	
It is important for the owls themselves to be quiet when hunti	ng so they can
sneak up on their prey. Barn owls have special	on their
wings that muffle sound, and a largeso th	ney can glide
rather than flap their wings. This gives them almost	flight and
they can catch their prey in their sharp withou	ıt ever being
heard!	

Their colouring also helps when catching prey. It was recently discovered that the stark _____ colour of a barn owl shocks small rodents, so they stay still for longer, giving the owl more time to catch them. It's a bit like seeing a _____!
