## Activity 3:

## Recreate the Crime Scene!

Right, detectives! Our next step is to recreate the crime scene so we can get a better idea of what happened! All the suspected murderous minibeasts are believed to be resting in their homes at the time that the crime was committed. a) Draw in the below features written in bold to recreate the crime scene:

1. The tarantula's burrow is in A1.
2. Webbing is covering $B 1$ and $A 2$.
3. There is a log covering C1, B2 and A3 and a different log covering D1, E2 and F3.
4. Long grasses cover E5 and E4.
5. The praying mantis is believed to be resting amongst some leaves in G6.
6. A huge bolder is in E6.
7. Sand covers A6, A7 and B7
8. The jewel wasp chambers are in A5.
9. The assassin bug's wood pile covers C3 and D3
b) Which out of the suspects could have possibly attacked the victim?
