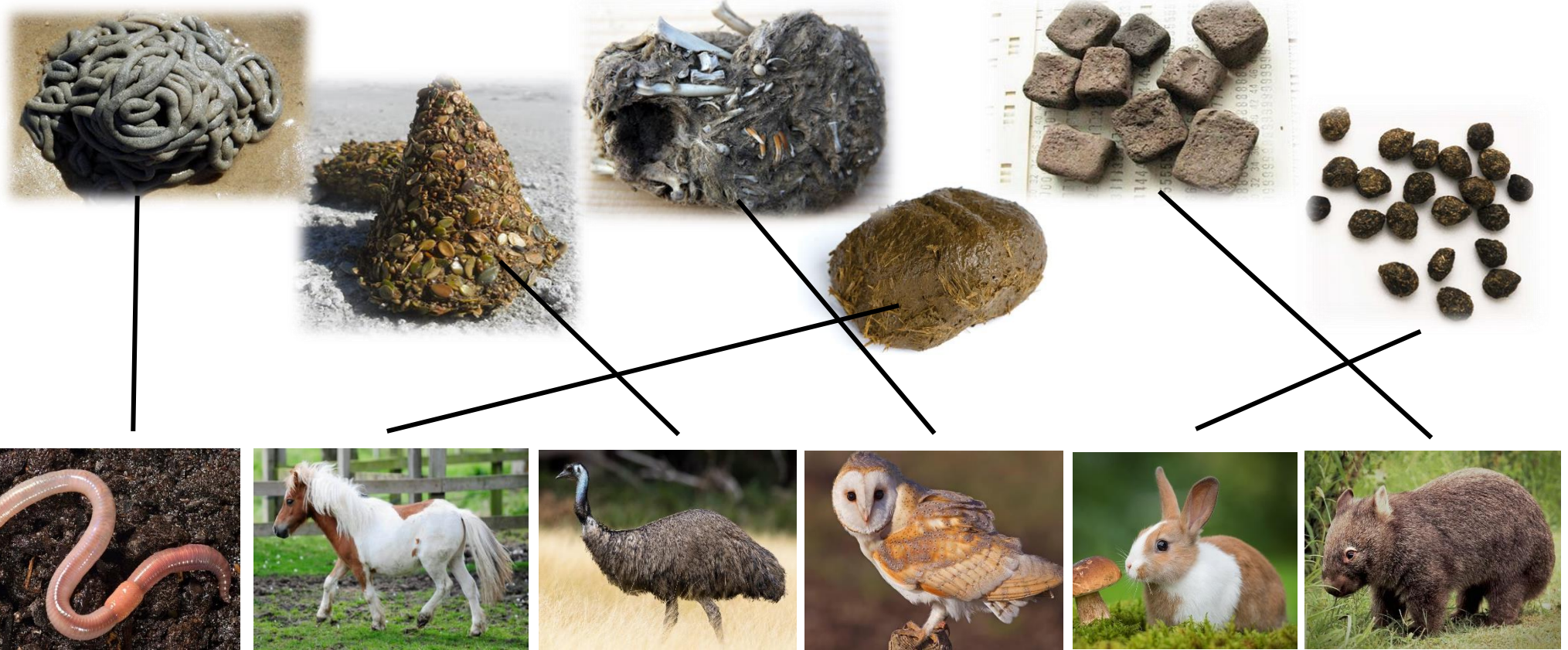

Answers



- 1) **Worm poo/cast:** Worms dig through soil by eating soil and then pooping it out of their tunnel.
- 2) **Emu poo:** emus eat seeds but don't always digest them. Their poo then helps the plants to grow.
- 3) **Owl pellet:** this is *sick*, not poo. It's filled with the parts of prey owls can't digest, like bones or fur.
- 4) **Pony poo:** horses don't digest all the grass they eat; you can spot some left in their poo!
- 5) **Wombat poo:** wombats are the only animals to have square or cube-shaped poo!
- 6) **Rabbit poo:** rabbits eat their poo to make sure they've eaten all the grass they can! Yuck!
