Hedgehogs live in gardens, parks and woods and come out at night. They like to look for slugs and insects to eat in the leaves.



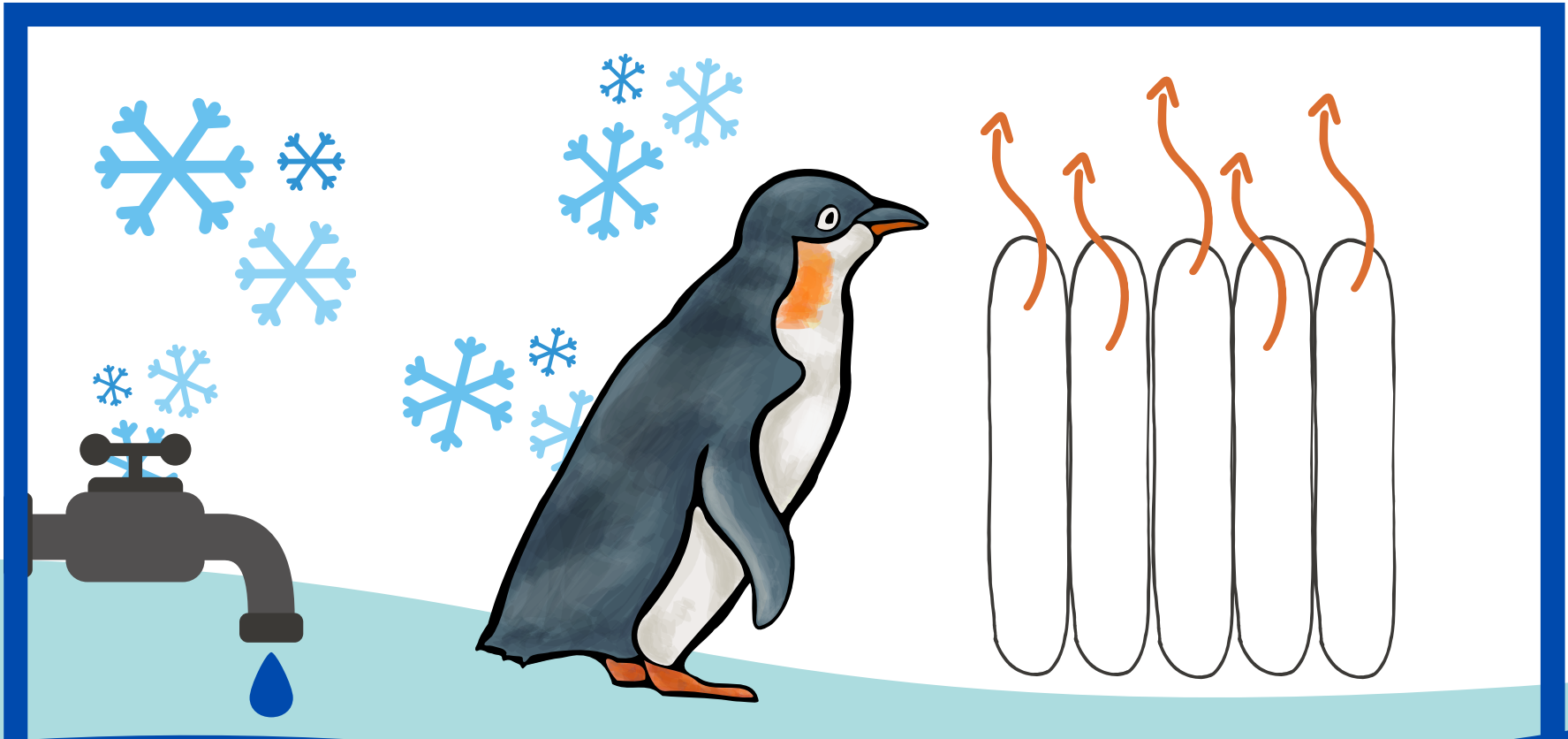
What is upsetting the hedgehog?

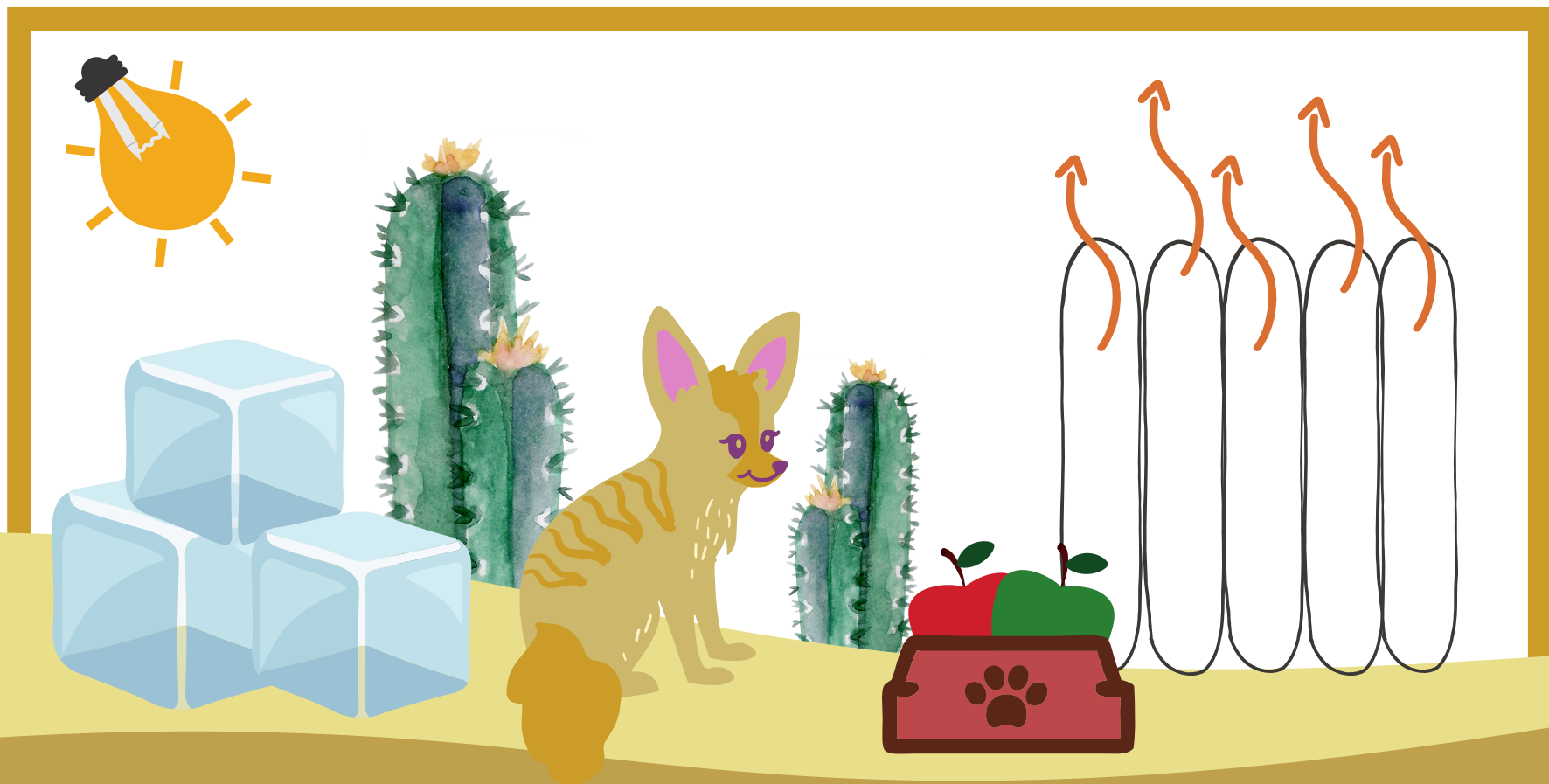

The hedgehog didn't like the Bright light.

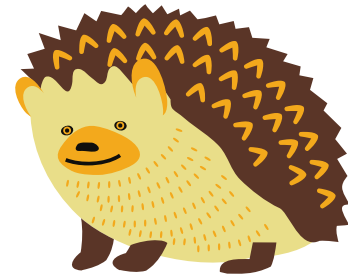
The penguin didn't like the Hheater or being Alone.
